FORMAL

If the wedding is during the day and the dress code is formal, your options are extended: you can wear a two-piece or three-piece suit of almost any color (avoid dark colors) with stripes, checks or plain. Choose materials such as cotton, linen or even a light wool that will make you feel comfortable and give a fresh image. Choose coffee-colored, camel, or wine-colored shoes or even blue shoes.

Cotton shirt from Brioni. Cotton suit (jacket 8990 and pants 4190) from Marchand Drapier for Saks Fifth Avenue. Silk tie (2100 pesos) from Emporio Armani. Leather belt (3960 pesos) from Gucci.

At night, wear a black, oxford grey or navy blue suit such as the one that Miguel Ángel is wearing, which can be combined with different tones of the same color. If you want a striped or checked pattern, go ahead, but it must be subtle. Finish it off with a plain tie or one with discrete stripes.

Cotton shirt (6499 pesos) from Brioni. Silk and wool suit from Ermengildo Zegna. Silk tie (2815 pesos) from Gucci. Vintage silk handkerchief. Leather shoes from Salvatore Ferragamo.

NIGHTTIME TROPICAL



This dress code, which also appears as such in some invitations, is also known as rigorous *guayabera*. The important thing is that, if it is a nighttime wedding, the *guayabera* should be long-sleeved. Pastel colors are a good alternative to stand apart from all white, beige or black clothing, without losing the elegance. Avoid a jacket at all costs.

Linen guayabera (2100 pesos) from Carla Fernández. Linen pants (part of a suit, 14 890 pesos) from Corneliani. Plated leather shoes (8400 pesos) from Salvatore Ferragamo.



DAYTIME TROPICAL



Once again the *guayabera* is the indispensable element in this dress code, and we suggest once more that you choose a pastel tone. Finish off the look with substantial laced shoes, although you could also wear espadrilles or leather sandals.

Linen guayabera (2300 pesos) from Carla Fernández. Cotton-linen pants (3940 pesos) and leather shoes (12600 pesos), both from Salvatore Ferragamo.

FORMAL DRESS

Make the difference with silk handkerchiefs in contrasting colors such as red, blue or purple. As for the sash, designs with spots or stripes are appropriate, although the classic black will make you look impeccable. If you prefer a tie, it should be skinny and black.

Cotton shirt (7899 pesos) from Brioni. Wool tuxedo from Ermenegildo Zegna. Silk tie and sash (4899 pesos and 1899 pesos) from Brioni. Leather shoes (8285 pesos) from Gucci.

The formal dress is most appropriate for weddings at night, but some brides and grooms are subject to fits of creativity and choose this dress code even when the ceremony is at day time. If you doubt it, we propose this look with a light-colored tuxedo and a pastel colored sash.

Cotton shirt (6900 pesos) from Emporio Armani. Cotton tuxedo (jacket 9390 pesos and pants 4390) from March and Drapier for Saks Fifth Avenue. Silk sash tie from Ermenegildo Zegna. Cotton and metal cufflinks (1290 pesos) from Hackett. (Prices at point of sale.)





COLONIAL AT DUSK



This time we were the creative ones, and we invented this dress code in order to refer to the weddings celebrated at dusk in places such as San Miguel de Allende. In these cases, linen is an excellent alternative for passing from day to night.

You can do without the tie and opt for a handkerchief with a folk pattern. And don't wear a belt.

Cotton-linen shirt (5899 pesos) and linen-wool jacket (42 899 pesos), both from Brioni. Linen pants from Z.Zegna. Leather shoes from Louis Vuitton. Silk handkerchief (1500 pesos) from Eiro.

NOONTIME COLONIAL
